

A Recount of the 2023 Creek to Bay Clean Up

Greetings San Diego,

My name is Christina Vialva, and I am honored to hold the title of Member-at-Large for the San Diego ACS executive board. A couple of weekends ago, our section participated in the annual "Creek to Bay Cleanup" in honor of Earth Day, organized by the local nonprofit, I Love a Clean San Diego, for the second year in a row! I had the pleasure of leading a team of amazing ACS volunteers who helped collect over one hundred pounds of environmentally harmful trash across the coast of the beautiful Chula Vista Wildlife Refuge in just a couple of hours. While working alongside other groups representing local businesses and schools, our ACS section helped support the natural habitat and nesting grounds of endangered species native to our region, including the light-footed Ridgeway's rail, California least tern, and salt marsh bird's-beak species. In addition to our efforts to provide a clean marsh environment for the native wildlife, the event was an educational opportunity to learn more about the colorful history of San Diego's South Bay territory, as told by our group's captain and guide through the terrain. Upon leaving the site, I couldn't help but feel good about how the small amount of time I shared with our ACS community connected me with so many like-minded and caring local leaders with the drive to give back some love to their surroundings.

Treasurer's Report (DG) – Waiting allotment and dues payments, ~\$30 in interest: expenses \$1021 food for Click Chem Backstory, line 61 \$525, GSD Science & Engineering Fair awards (an extra award because a duo team doing one project) checks have been mailed, storage unit cost, Vanguard account up; tax returns for past 3 years have been submitted to National; councilors need to submit reimbursement requests.

<u>**Click Chemistry Seminar</u> (JM) – Don Lewis presented the backstory regarding preparing the patent for click chemistry that led to the recent Nobel Prize for Dr. Sharpless, 53 attending, comfortable venue, in-person event was welcome.</u></u>**

<u>Super STEM Saturday</u> (JGG for JT) – 11,700 attendees, SWC hosted urethane foam bugs – traditional favorite.

<u>Chem Expo</u> (JGG) – Jackie needs help to organize, Miramar College not available.

National Meeting Council Meeting (JGG) – Streamline councilor expense policy, approved candidates for President and directors.

Greater SD Science & Eng Fair (JS) – 14 volunteers as judges, fewer projects by ~20%, good presentations, including the quality of the junior division (middle school) and number of topics has expanded, projects include several sophisticated instruments, suggestion to invite winners to repeat their presentations at Chem Expo; award winners from SDACS: Junior Division 1st Place - Ethan Leem, Pacific Trails Middle School, *Most Effective Natural Anti-Bacterial Agent*; 2nd Place (Team) - Adam Jaimovich, Zakari Sayed, The Rhoades Schools, *Efficacy of Various Spice Extracts in Combating Potential Stimulant Hazards*; 3rd Place - Yusra Qarar, Bright Horizon Academy, *Will Soaking Food in Water Before Cooking Remove Starch from It?*; Senior Division 1st Place - Andrew Tsui, Canyon Crest Academy, *Novel High-Throughput Screening and Identification of FDA-Approved Drugs for Alzheimer's Disease Treatment*; 2nd Place - Rishika Kulkarni, Francis Parker School, *Novel PSS-Driven Ligand Exchange on the Surface of Gold Nanocubes*; 3rd Place - Anirudh Kalyanaraman, Mt. Carmel High School, *Cobinamide - A Novel Antioxidant to Protect Against Polyaromatic Hydrocarbon-Induced Cardiac Cytotoxicity.*
