San Diego Section, American Chemical Society Executive Committee - Zoom Meeting June 1, 2023, 6:30 p.m.

<u>Attendees:</u> Sean Anderson, Surya De, Juan Gonzalez-Gonzalez (chair), Desiree Grubisha (treasurer), Carolina Ibarra, Valerie Kuck, Julann Miller, Jim Shih, Bill Tolley (secretary), David Wallace

<u>May ExComm Minutes</u> (JJG) – May minutes edits: Treasurer's rpt need expenditure corrected: \$225 for Newsletter preparation, \$145 social media, \$132 for storage locker; not a quorum to vote to accept May minutes

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> (**DG**) – Income: received first portion of annual allotment \$19,991.69; expenses: networking event \$2118; picnic rebated \$106 of \$323 deposit because SDACS is non-profit organization; \$132 storage, \$225 Newsletter preparation, \$145 for storage locker; Vanguard Fund little net change

Motion: Transfer a portion of the funds at SDCCU to 4% certificate account – David to draft a motion for an e-mail vote

Stone Brewery Networking Event (JGG) -- 25 attendees, plenty of food, good variety of attendees, several new faces, food availability was appropriate, location convenient for some of the attendees, which may explain why some of the new folks attended; should consider repeating the event and try for a sponsor

SABPA / SDACS Joint Seminar (DW) – Early discussion in progress about inviting two East-coast speakers to travel to SD for separate events; both SABPA and SDACS needing to re-establish connections with sponsors and venues post-pandemic; Lilly is open to hosting external events but requires a firm guest list before the event and guests need to remain in the seminar area; the conference room can hold up to ~150 persons; suggestion that an event at SDSU would allow a the room size to match the expected attendance; no quorum to vote on expenditure for speaker travel

Project SEED (VK) – Two students have submitted final forms, two potential students have not submitted forms so Val is needing direction from National as to whether we can include these latter two

Future Seminars (VK) – Trying to schedule Michael Chiang on microplastics, wondering regarding comfort level of potential attendees to in-person events; Section received funds to purchase electronic equipment to allow for hybrid events which at this point have not been spent

Action: Juan to arrange for purchasing new projector





<u>Sr. Chemists Breakfasts</u> (VK) – Sr. Chemists activities have stopped Action: Val to poll sr. members regarding resuming breakfasts and 50-Year member luncheon

<u>Nominations</u> (**JGG**) – The Section needs to identify members willing to fill leadership positions; ExComm positions for which there are no incumbents – Juan as chair, Bill Tolley as secretary, Julann Miller as Alt. Councilor

Action: a call for nominations should be included in each Newsletter and on social media
