

November ExComm Minutes – No quorum to approve minutes

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> (DG) – **Income:** \$1,177 Holiday party revenue from Eventbrite, \$30 deposit from national (untitled), \$10,450 deposit from national (untitled) **Expenses**: \$33.87 Chem Expo, \$36.78 Holiday Party, \$100 gift card for speaker, \$155 storage locker, \$225 newsletter, \$81 social media.

2024 Budget Update (All) –No quorum to vote on 2024 budget; an email vote will be proposed leading up to the February ExComm meeting with proposed budget.

<u>UCSD/SD-ACS Travel Grant Proposal</u> (HS) – Proposal for SD-ACS to fund UCSD student affiliates to attend the spring ACS meeting. Discussion about concerns over the Local Sections being prohibited from selective funding of specific members; however, if the 2024 budget includes a line about extending funding opportunity to all SA members, fall 2024 meeting travel could possibly be funded. Excomm advised HS to apply for grants available on ACS website for undergrads.

<u>Chem Expo Debrief</u> (CV, JT) – Attendance boosted from garnering attention from scouts, ACS patch in development and a good incentive. Struggling to attract larger crowds due to teachers not offering extra credit.

<u>SABPA/ACS Seminar at Novartis Debrief</u> (DW) – Turnout at Novartis event was excellent. Novartis to be considered as a venue again in the future; ample parking and security was waived. Company showed great interest in the event topic.





2023 End-of-year Meeting and Holiday Party Debrief (CV, JS, JGG) – Great feedback from audience about the reflection of LS events and a preview into some of the events in progress for 2024. Buffet style dinner service was efficient. Possible idea for 2024 holiday dinner – utilizing dinner room space to set up posters and graphics about the events that were executed throughout the year.

<u>Member-at-Large write in: Jim O'Brian</u> – Due to high volume of write-in votes for a member at large position, Jim O Brian has accepted the role as a new member at large.

January Seminar (CV) – Tues. Jan 30th, Connie Weaver from SDSU, "What's all the Fuss about Ultra Processed Foods?", Advertising to begin on Monday, Jan 8th, meeting to be over Zoom.

<u>DEIR/IPG Grant Updates</u> (CV, JGG) – DEIR grant awarded \$1800 to SD-ACS. Request for subcommittee to be formed over the next month or two. Jim offered connection to the Eli Lilly PRIDE director. IPG proposal in good shape; submission deadline is Jan 15th.

<u>Potential February Event: Chemical Communications</u> (All) – Christina proposed the idea of planning an event for February to the Valentine's Day festivities. Chemical communications, or the chemistry behind scents, flavorings, etc. Ryan to reach out to a client who may be interested or well connected in the field.

Bylaws update (RS, CV, JGG) – Bylaw subcommittee to meet on Friday, 1/12 to make progress on a working draft of the updated bylaws for the LS. When ready, the new bylaw proposal will be sent out to the ExComm for an email vote of approval before being submitted.
